



Wedding Information: Facility

This sheet will provide you with important information about how we handle weddings here at Gibbon Baptist Church. Weddings are an important part of our church's ministry in and for the Gibbon community. We are honored as a church to be involved in one of the most important ceremonies of your life and will do what we can to be of assistance to you.

We consider weddings to be a Christian worship service. As such, weddings here at Gibbon Baptist Church are led by myself as pastor of the church or by an officiant approved by both myself and the Board of Deacons. If you are interested in having me serve as your officiant, please see "Wedding Information: Officiant" document available from the church office.

What You Provide

- You are a man and a woman desiring a Christian wedding.
- You will need to get a marriage license through any county clerk in Nebraska.
- You will need to pay any fees associated with your wedding prior to Gibbon Baptist placing it on our calendar. Please see "Facility Usage & Fees" document for all pertinent information.

What the Officiant Provides

- The officiant completes at least 5 premarital counseling sessions with you as a couple over at least a 5-week period.
- The officiant helps you plan your order of service and will typically lead your rehearsal.
- The officiant ensures on the wedding day that the marriage license is properly completed.

- Facility use (sanctuary and/or fellowship hall)
- Organist/pianist
- Sound system
- Officiant
